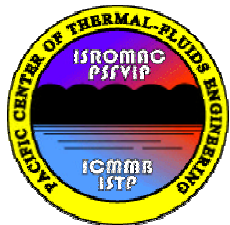

### Background

The fourth Pacific Symposium on Flow Visualization and Image Processing will be held on June 3-5, 2003 under the auspices of the Pacific Center of Thermal-Fluids Engineering. After three editions in the middle of “Pacific Ocean”, PSFVIP4 invites you to visit Chamonix, France, and to take a tour to the “Sea of Ice”, in the most important European mountain range.

### Scope

The objective of the Symposium is to provide a forum for communication and information exchange. Papers describing current research on flow visualization and image processing from principles to applications are hereby solicited. Those pertaining to fundamental techniques and applications are appropriate. Topics include, but are not limited to, flow-field visualization, surface flow visualization, computer-assisted flow visualization, graphical display of data set, digital image processing and others.

### Selection of Papers

The official language is English. Initial selection will be based on a submitted abstract of about 500 English words (1 page for the text and 1 page for figures and images). The abstract should contain : (1) paper title, (2) three keywords chosen in the list available on the symposium web site, (3) authors names, (4) address, phone number, fax and email address of the author to whom subsequent correspondence should be directed. The abstract should contain sufficient information to enable the scope and nature of the paper to be assessed. The review will be a two steps process. After the abstracts are received and the authors are notified of the results, the selected authors will be asked to submit a full manuscript for review. Final acceptance will be based on review of the full manuscript. All accepted papers will be published in the CD-ROM proceedings to be distributed prior to the symposium.

### Selection of Journal Papers

If desired by the authors, the papers presented at the symposium can be automatically submitted to the Journal of Flow Visualization and Image Processing. Publication in the journal will depend upon passing a further review conducted after the symposium.

Abstract submission: Sep. 30<sup>th</sup> 2002

Notification of abstract acceptance : Nov. 15<sup>th</sup> 2002

Full length manuscript submission : Jan. 15<sup>th</sup> 2003

Final manuscript due : Mar. 1<sup>st</sup> 2003

The conference proceedings will be released on CD-ROM. Authors are allowed to include in their papers colour figures, video clips and animations.
